

# The First Sunday of Advent

December 1, 2024

Almighty God, give us grace to cast away the works of darkness, and put on the armor of light, now in the time of this mortal life in which your Son Jesus Christ came to visit us in great humility; that in the last day, when he shall come again in his glorious majesty to judge both the living and the dead, we may rise to the life immortal; through him who lives and reigns with you and the Holy Spirit, one God, now and for ever. Amen. (Collect for the First Sunday of Advent)

Welcome to Advent. The prayer above is the Collect of the Day for the First Sunday of Advent. The Collect of the Day is the thematic prayer we hear near the beginning of each Sunday service. The first Sunday of Advent is also called Advent Sunday, and the collect for this first Sunday sets the tone for the whole season: In Advent--which derives from the Latin adventus, meaning "coming" or "arrival"--the Church looks toward both the birth of the Christ Child at Christmas and also the Second Coming of Jesus at the end of the ages.

We unfold another layer of meaning in Advent when we look at the original Greek of the New Testament. The word translated into Latin as adventus is parousia, which not only means "arrival" or "coming," but also "presence." Parousia is not only one moment in time, but an ongoing, eternal Presence. God is always with us, but Advent is a time to create a little more quiet space in our hearts for the Divine Presence, even amidst the abundance of the holiday season.


#### Trinity Kids on Christmas Eve!
